MINUTES OF THE APRIL 26, 2006, BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by President Rick Treiber.

Karo read the minutes of the April 19, 2006, BOD meeting. Jim moved with second by Bob that the minutes be approved as read. Vote taken; motion carried.

1. Rita drew Ed Pickart’s name in the weekly lottery drawing. John Skola’s name was drawn last week; he contacted the office and received a \$20 credit on his account.
2. Jim Beeghly reported that Gabriel Lenz was selected as the 2006 recipient of the Bill Kimble Flight Scholarship. Gabriel is currently a junior at Solon High School and works at Fareway in North Liberty. The manager of Fareway requested a picture of Gabriel in front of an airplane he will be flying. The picture and a little article will be published in the Fareway newsletter.
