



Learn to Fly This Summer!



Members of the Green Castle Aero Club would like to welcome candidates to apply for the *Green Castle 2010 Summer Flight Training Scholarship*. Each year we honor the memory of Bill Kimble, one of our founding members, by awarding the chance to learn to fly to a deserving high school student who is at

least 16 and no more than 18 by the time he or she begins training. The scholarship is especially designed to encourage a young man or woman who is giving serious thought to a career in flying or a related field. The scholarship recipient will need to demonstrate a commitment to learning to fly by obtaining a flight physical and by investing the necessary time and energy to make regular progress towards obtaining a private pilot's license by the end of the season. In return, the Aero Club will provide flight lessons by Aero Club approved FAA certified flight instructors at the Green Castle airport as well as associated expenses such as the packet of instructional materials, the cost of the written test and the cost of the check ride required to obtain a private pilot's license, approximately a \$4000.00 value.
